# INTRODUCTION TO **SCHOOLS PROGRAMME**

Since 1994, we've been using the power of football and community partnerships to make a difference.

Originally known as Lincoln City Football in the Community (FiTC), we became a charity in 2009, expanding our reach and impact. With over 29 years of experience, our dedicated team of over thirty staff and volunteers remains agile and creative, always putting local needs first.

Our Sport & Physical Activity programmes harness the power of sport to inspire individuals to engage in regular physical activity, improving their physical and mental wellbeing. We champion healthy and active lifestyles for children and young people while addressing inequalities in participation for females, ethnic minority groups, individuals with disabilities, and those from our most disadvantaged communities.

Our Schools Programme includes PPA cover, enrichment activities such as after-school clubs, and PE teacher CPD. Over recent years partner schools have represented us at a variety of excited events connected with the Premier League and National FA, such as a football tournament at St George's Park with Prince William in attendance. We have also hosted a number of enriching events at our home the LNER Stadium, most recently an author day with Tom Palmer in our Community Hub facility.




# **OUR APPROACH**

- Developmental: All participants should learn and develop in sport, physical activity, or subject areas. Skills learned should be applicable outside of sessions.
